## Corsets, and Fans, and Tea.- Oh, My!

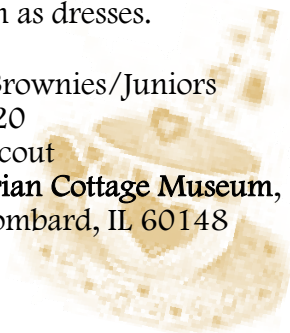
