Call for Artists

The Lombard Historical Society is pleased to announce the second annual Lilac Time Poster Competition. The winning piece of original artwork created will be reproduced for the Lombard Historical Society 2023 Lilac Time Poster. The marketability of the artwork will be a prime consideration of the selection criteria.

Entry Requirements:

- Artists submitting an entry must be age 18 or older.
- One entry per artist will be accepted.
- Acrylic, digital, oil and water color will be accepted.
- The artwork created must reproduce well as a poster and must be an original work.
- Artwork containing any trademarks, logos, brandings, etc. will not be accepted.
- Identifiable markings, signatures, initials, etc., will not be accepted.
- All submissions must be portrait oriented.

Contest Theme

Submissions must depict the contest theme of "Legends & Lore of Lilacia Park."

Jurors & Selection Process

The jury, consisting of the Executive Director of the Lombard Historical Society, the President of the Board of the Lombard Historical Society, and others TBD, will select the winning artwork. Decisions of the Jury will be final.

Submission Process

High Resolution JPEG or TIFF files (in CMYK format, 300dpi or larger) must be submitted via WeTransfer to info@lombardhistory.org. Instructions can be found at wetransfer.com; click on

"Help." The size of the poster, when printed, will be 24" X 36" or 11" X 17." The size of the poster will be determined by the Executive Director of the Lombard Historical Society based on marketability.

Deadline for Submissions

Images of the artwork and a short artist statement must be received by 11:59 pm Saturday, April 1, 2023.

The artist statement must be 250 words or less.

Release

By submitting an entry to this competition, all artists agree to have their artwork posted online.

By signing this contract, the winning artist(s) will retain ownership of the original artwork, but irrevocably assigns to the Lombard Historical Society exclusive copyright, trademark, licensing, marketing, distribution, reproduction and registration rights to the artwork for any and all purposes and uses for perpetuity.

Winners

First, Second and Third Place Winners will be announced on Friday, May 5, 2023 at 6 pm at the Lombard Historical Society Reveal. (Light refreshments will be served.)

Posters will be available for purchase immediately following the announcement at the Lombard Historical Society Lilac Emporium Gift Shop and at the LHS booth at the Craft Fair the next day, Saturday, May 6, 2023.

Prizes

First Place: A night at the Westin, framed copy of their poster and an individual membership to the Lombard Historical Society

Second Place: a copy of *Lilac Time*, the book; lilac themed magnet and mug from the Lilac Emporium Gift Shop, and an individual membership to the Lombard Historical Society.
